

Information Needed!

The Custer County Emergency Response Committee needs your help.

In order to assess damages incurred by the recent heavy rains, the office of Custer County Emergency Management needs to provide the Nebraska Emergency Management Agency with information.

The state agency needs to know if your home or business sustained damage in the recent flood and the extent of this damage. The office of Custer County Emergency Management and CCERC is helping gather this information. If your home or business is in Custer County and your home or business sustained damage give a call to one of the numbers listed below and let the CCERC know which category the damage to your home or business falls under:

Minor – the building is damaged and may be used under limited conditions with minor repairs

Major – the building is damaged to the extent that it is no longer usable and may be returned to service only with extensive repairs.

Destroyed – the building is a total loss or damaged to the extent that it is no longer usable and is not economically feasible to repair.

Or if the access to your home or business, i.e. roadway, culvert, etc. leading into your home or business received damage

Please call one of the following numbers between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. this Friday or Saturday (June 18 or June 19) and let the CCERC know. The information will be used to help speed up the necessary timeframe and the possibility of individual assistance for home and/or business owners within the county.
