

**MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL  
CITY OF SARGENT, NEBRASKA  
Special Session  
Sargent Community Center  
June 29, 2006**

Legal and Public Notice being duly given as required by law, the special session of the Mayor and Council of the City of Sargent, Nebraska, was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Griebel. The following council members were present at roll call: Oeltjen, Kozeal, Mankle, and Nitchie.

Oeltjen moved to approve the agenda. Mankle seconded. Vote all yea.

The Council discussed whether to rent out or sell the old tables from the Community Center. It was agreed to have them sold at auction the next time Curt Sillivan has a sale.

The condition of the structure at 502 West Anna Street was discussed. Kozeal made a motion to declare the building is over 50% destroyed. Mankle seconded. Vote all yea.

A discussion followed regarding grazing the land at the sewer lagoon. Mick Kozeal would like to put up a fence and graze the property. It was agreed to have a five-year contract drawn up between Mr. Kozeal and the City of Sargent.

The mayor, the city council, administrator, utility superintendent and Ms. Corrine Pedersen all went on a tour of the town. This was followed with a council retreat to review the things that are both successful in town and things that need improved upon.

Nitchie moved to adjourn. Oeltjen seconded. Vote all yea. Meeting adjourned at 9:05 p.m.
